(Extracted from the ASWA Constitution and By-Laws)

8.0 State Team Representation

8.1 Selection Committee

State Team selection shall be made by a Sub Committee (herein called the Selection Committee) especially constituted for this purpose. The Selection Committee is charged with the responsibility of selecting the best possible State Team from nominees completing all prior requisites.

8.2 Registration

(a) Archers registering for State Team Representation should ensure that they are able to attend their respective National Championships.

(b) Club Recorders shall check Archers who nominate, that they are at least a First Class Target Archer in the division nominated for. If any Archer obtains their First Class rating after the close of registration and up to the time of selection, they can be included for consideration for their respective State Team at the discretion of the Selection Committee.

(c) Archers shall nominate on the Registration Form. and pay the Registration Fee as set by Council from time to time. Archers shall nominate their chosen bow type on the registration form and shall shoot the prescribed selection rounds so as to be considered for selection, using their nominated bow type.

(d) Nominations shall commence from 1st January of each year.

(e) Registration closing date for Senior and Junior Team selection is 31st August of each year.

8.3 Selection

(a) There shall be 6 Target rounds and 3 Field rounds (for Junior archers, 1 Clout round in addition to the Target and Field rounds) from the nomination date until the selection date. Archers changing age groups between team selection and their respective Nationals, must shoot at least one First Class score in their new division to prove their ability to cope with their respective rounds. Team selection dates shall be:-

(i) Senior Team before 31st October

(ii) Junior Team before 31st October

(b) Senior and Junior archers must compete in at least one (1) 48 target FITA Field Round and two (2) Target Rounds. Junior archers must also shoot one (1) Clout round if this event is applicable to their National Championships requirements.

(c) Senior and Junior archers must achieve at least a First Class score in one of their respective Target rounds.

(d) All Archers must compete in the State Championships Target and Field events (Juniors also in the Clout if required), except where exceptional circumstances preclude participation. Archers who claim exemption must

advise the Selection Committee within seven days after the event their reason for non-participation. The Selection Committee will consider the reason and advise the archer of their decision. If no advice is received within this prescribed time the Committee will deem the Archer/s ineligible for selection.

(e) An exemption may be considered by the Selection Committee for archers in remote areas when circumstances prevent them from attending the prescribed State Championship events. If exemption is given, the archer must shoot the same event on their home ground on the same day with results duly witnessed and forwarded to the Selection Committee.

(f) A State training squad, from which the final team shall be selected, shall be named two months before the selection date.

(g) The State Junior and Senior training squad may consist of up to eight in each division.

(h) The State training squad shall be entitled to wear a training squad T-shirt which shall be paid for by the squad members and which can be worn at any State run tournament in that year.

(i) State Team members shall agree in writing to comply with the conditions of the Society.

(j) Archers shall not withdraw from registered shoots without a justifiable reason. Prior to withdrawal they must notify the Field Captain (Director of Shooting) of the reason for withdrawal. Inclement weather is not a justifiable reason unless the Field Captain/D.O.S. abandons the shoot.

(k) Archers must maintain an acceptable standard of dress and behaviour.

(l) The training squad must train together as nominated by the Coaching Committee/State Coach.

(m) Performance is to be a key element of assessing the merits of training squad members for Team selection.

(n) Representation for Australia during the selection period will be considered for State Team selection.

(o) When a State Team is selected, the members shall be notified as soon as possible by the Selection Committee.

(p) Last minute withdrawals, without valid reason, from the team after the start of the National Championships would result in the member being removed from consideration the following year.
