Total Entry Fees must accompany the entry form, unless special arrangements are made with the Organising Committee.

LATE ENTRIES

Late entries will only be accepted up to 16 March 2012 by and at the discretion of the Organising Committee and are subject to the availability of shooting positions.

A late entry fee of 50% is applicable.

Date of birth is required to be completed by all competitors except in the Open Division.

FIELD COURSE

Appropriate footwear is essential when shooting the field course. Archers may provide an Archer's Agent for scoring and collection of arrows if they are not fully able. The field course is in a nature park adjacent to the Murrumbidgee River Corridor and there is a lot of wildlife, including kangaroos and snakes, which are protected in the area. Smoking is not permitted on the field course due to the risk of fire.

MEDALS

Medals will be awarded in accordance with the minimum requirements of Archery Australia. These will be awarded and presented at the venues on completion of each event. If medals have to be forwarded after the event, any costs incurred will be at the competitor's expense, except as approved by the Organising Committee.

Visitor Medals will be awarded to Archery Alliance and International archers in all categories, including archers competing in the Field Bowhunter competition.

PRACTICE

Practice prior to the Official Practice day is available at the Tuggeranong Archery Club field at Soward Way, Greenway on 24th March. Please contact Rachel Morgan 0488 400 232.

PRESENTATION EVENING

The Presentation Event, including a served seated dinner, will be held on Friday 30 March at The Vikings Club Town Centre, Tuggeranong following completion of shooting for the day at approximately 7.00pm. Alcohol will be available for purchase.

Medals for the Thursday and Friday Target and Field events, and the gold medals for the overall Team events and awards for best archers, will be presented at the dinner.

RESULTS

It is the intention that the complete results will be available on the Tuggeranong website after the completion of the tournament on Friday 30 March and also be published on the Archery Australia website.

RULES

All events will be conducted to FITA & Archery Australia Rules, as appropriate.

The Field Bowhunter event will be shot under ABA Bowhunter Unlimited category from the Red pegs with bow weight restricted to 80lbs due to existing safety requirements with the Tuggeranong Field Butts.

TEAM TROPHIES

Teams representing Regional Divisions are eligible to compete for the Aggregate Trophies and medals. The names of team members are required to be registered by the relevant RGB (or a duly authorised representative) with the Organising Committee by the completion of the Official Practice on Sunday 25 March 2012.

VENUES

All events are being held at Tuggeranong Archery Club, Soward Way, Greenway
Target will be held on Greenway Oval, Soward Way, Greenway.

TRANSPORT
